TYPES 1 - 6

Ukraine collecting offers an exciting opportunity for collectors to obtain unique and priceless items of Ukrainian history for less than 100 dollars !

The best place to start, is the collecting of Ukrainian postcards. There are virtually no forgeries, they are beautiful, and they are cheap ! The added benefit is that with luck, a used postcard can be purchased with valuable Ukrainian postal history, for just the price of the original postcard !

You do not need to be rich to be a Ukraine collector, in fact the poorer you are and the more limited your budget, the more exciting collecting becomes, as you attempt to make every dollar count !

The Roman Dubyniak Ukrainian Museum Foundation is happy to provide a 'free of charge' opinion on any Ukrainian postcard, preferably from the original, but also from good copies of *both* sides. Advice and collecting help is free, simply write to the Foundation !

The best place to start in any collecting area, is where there are no catalogues, so prices are cheap, and just a little knowledge, like the Ukrainian language and any known literature, makes YOU the expert.

Ukrainian Legion Postcards offer such an opportunity !

The Ukrainian Legion, 1914 - 1918, was the FIRST Ukrainian military formation of modern times, and the first Ukrainian military formation for many generations.

The 'War Council' of the Ukrainian Legion issued postcards (and stamps) to raise funds for the Legion, and to provide a visual record of the deeds and exploits of the Ukrainian Legion for the Ukrainian population, who eagerly awaited news of the Legion.

The nearest thing to a catalogue is the listing provided by Borys Zayachivsky in the 'Drohobytiskiy Kolektsioner' No1 (14) 2002. We have found little or nothing else !

Dr Kyrylo Trylovskiy is the true founder of Ukrainian Legion postcards.

A co-founder of the Ukrainian Radical party which from the turn of the century fought for Ukrainian rights against the Austrian authorities, the Church - both Roman and Russian, Polish Landlords, and the Poles who occupied all the positions of power over the Ukrainian population of Halychyna, and kept Ukrainians as second class citizens and denied them their rights.

Against Polish opposition he formed for the first time Ukrainian "Sich" semi-military groups, based on traditional Kozak military lines, throughout the towns and villages of Halychyna. Officially they were volunteer "Fire-Fighting" groups, as the Poles could not oppose such formations.

In 1913, against strong Polish opposition, he managed to establish the "Ukrainian Sich Riflemen", by copying word for word the constitution of the Polish "Stszelcy" riflemen organisation.

In 1914 he became the head of the "Ukrainian War Council" and despite Polish opposition, the "Ukrainian Legion" was formed.

TYPE 1 "Red Cross" Issue

In 1914 or 1915, the "Ukrainian War Council" managed to obtain permission to issue just 3 postcards for either the Sich riflemen or the Ukrainian Legion. They did this by telling the authorities that the postcards were to be issued for the benefit of the "Red Cross" something that the authorities could not oppose. However they must have been allowed only a minimal printing, for after 50 years of searching, we have only found 1 card, though Borys Zayachivsky reports 3 different cards known. Note the 'Josefstädterstrasse 79' address.

TYPE 2 "Brown Front" Issue


Once the principle of issuing postcards had been established by the Type 1 issue. The authorities now faced with the problems of winning the war, could not oppose the issue of postcards for the benefit of military formations. The "War Council" of the Ukrainian Legion took full advantage and issued a further 11 Types of Ukrainian Legion postcard between 1914 and 1918. In addition postcards were issued by the Ukrainian Legion Press Office and by the Komisariat of the Ukrainian Legion in Volodymyr Volynskiy and Podillia. For the Type 2 postcards, 11 different fronts have been found and Borys Zayachivsky reports a 12th. The earliest known used date of a Ukrainian Legion postcard is found on a Type 2 postcard dated, 22.8.1915 Vienna, Austria.

TYPE 3 “Blue Front” Issue

To follow the 3 Type 1 postcards, and the 12 different fronts of the Type 2 postcards, Type 3 postcards were numbered from 16 to 27. 12 blue postcards of Type 3 to match the 12 brown postcards of Type 2.

TYPE 4 The “Emblem of the Legion” Issue

The very first COLOUR postcard of the Ukrainian Legion.

TYPE 5 The “Berlin” Issues

It appears the authorities had allowed 20 cards to be printed of this Issue. To get round this ‘local difficulty’ the printers simply printed “in error”, the various required postcards for the War Council of the Ukrainian Legion. For example no.1 14 has 4 different fronts known!

TYPE 6 The “Austrian Photographic Society” Issues

Again complete chaos in the numbering system of this Type. We think as the Series 2 postcards are numbered from 1 to 35 (Type 6e - Type 6i), then there could have been a further 35 un-numbered postcards (Type 6a - Type 6d). That is, there was official permission for 70 postcards. However the Type 6i “1917 ‘a’ series” may have produced a further 35 cards. So there could be 105 postcards of Type 6, and even more if there were additional “error” printings.


















